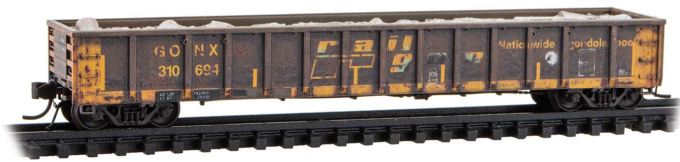

Weathered Railgon

52'6" Greenville 2494 Mill Gondola



This 52' 6" Railgon gondola was built in the early 1980s to a new design developed by Trailer Train's R&D department. The cars were 2,494 cubic feet in capacity and built to be heavy-duty and long lasting, carrying steel ingots, scrap steel and coiled steel. Trailer Train employed several manufacturers to build the nearly 4,000 GONX cars, including Greenville, Thrall, Pullman-Standard, and others.

Weathered CSX ex-Railgon

52'6" Greenville 2494 Mill Gondola



This 52' 6" Railgon gondola was built in the early 1980s to a new design developed by Trailer Train's R&D department. The cars were built to be heavy-duty and long lasting, carrying steel ingots, scrap steel and coiled steel. Trailer Train employed several manufacturers to build the nearly 4,000 GONX cars, including Greenville, Thrall, Pullman-Standard, and others. CSX was formed through the 1986 mergers of Chessie System and Seaboard System / Family Lines, and continues to operate today across more than 21,000 miles of track in the Eastern United States.

Weathered Wisconsin Central

52'6" Greenville 2494 Mill Gondola



This 52' 6" mill gondola was built in 1995 to a design very similar to Trailer Train's GONX gondolas. The cars were 2,494 cubic feet in capacity and built to be heavy-duty and long lasting, carrying steel ingots, scrap steel and coiled steel. Wisconsin Central Ltd. started operations in the mid-1980s, and became a subsidiary of Canadian National in 2001. It was based on the original Wisconsin Central founded in 1897 that was merged into the Soo Line in 1961.

BN ex-NP "Share in Freedom" Weathered 2-Pack

50' Single Door Standard Box Car without Roofwalk



This 50' boxcar was built in the early 1950s for Northern Pacific and repainted in the special "Share in Freedom; US Savings Bonds" red, white and blue paint scheme in 1968. Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific in 1970, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF.

Montana Rail Link Weathered 3-Pack

50' Single Door Rib Side Box Car without Roofwalk



Built in the mid-1970s for other roads, these cars eventually were obtained by Montana Rail Link and hastily repainted in MRL blue. MRL was founded in 1987, and was a profitable and critical link between BNSF and Union Pacific interchange points in the Western United States.

Weathered Pittsburgh & Lake Erie
50' Single Door Standard Box Car without Roofwalk



Commonly carrying coke and coal, P&LE operated from Ohio to Pennsylvania and West Virginia from 1875 to 1993 as a subsidiary of New York Central. P&LE also had a fleet of boxcars often marked with New York Central, later Penn Central, lettering.

Weathered Burlington Northern
50' Single Door Standard Box Car without Roofwalk



In 1970, Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF. BNSF is one of the largest freight railroads in the country with over 32,000 miles of rail.

Weathered Great Northern
40' Single Door Standard Box Car without Roofwalk



Great Northern was founded in 1889 and ran primarily in the Midwest and western states. In 1970, Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF. BNSF is one of the largest freight railroads in the country with over 32,000 miles of rail.

Weathered Pennsylvania
40' Single Door Standard Box Car without Roofwalk



Built in May 1950 for Pennsylvania, these 40' boxcars belonged to class X43B and featured Superior doors. They were rebuilt in the late 1960s and continued in service through the 1970s before being replaced by larger capacity 50' cars. Pennsylvania was a large Class 1 railroad formed in 1846 and grew to be a predominant shipper on the east coast until 1968 when it merged with rival New York Central to form Penn Central.

Weathered TTX with "Wrecked" Tank Car Load Kit
89' TOFC Flat Car



This PSH20-class 89' TTX flat car was used for general purpose bulk loading of construction equipment, industrial machinery, or in this case, a wrecked tank car. TTX was established in 1955 as "Trailer Train," and as their business evolved simply became "TTX" in a 1991 rebranding effort.

Weathered Railbox

50' Single Door Rib Side Box Car without Roofwalk



Built in 1978 by Pacific Car & Foundry for Railbox, this 50' boxcar was placed into Railbox series 20400-20899, and belonged to class XCF11A. A subsidiary of TTX, Railbox was founded in 1974 to address a nationwide boxcar shortage by creating a large pool of free-running boxcars seen from coast to coast.

Weathered Burlington Northern ex-Railbox

50' Single Door Rib Side Box Car without Roofwalk



Built in 1975 by Pacific Car & Foundry for Railbox, this 50' boxcar was hastily re-patched and placed into Burlington Northern series 250219-250481. Burlington Northern was formed through the mergers of Great Northern and Northern Pacific in 1970, and then merged with ATSF in 1995 to form BNSF.

Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe Weathered 2-Pack with M1 Abrams Tank Kits

57' Converted TOFC Flat Car



Built in the early 1960s for the Atchison, Topeka & Santa Fe, these general-purpose flat cars were serviced in the early 1980s, and were often seen hauling Department of Defense components like military vehicles. Featuring a cushioned underframe, they were well suited to delicate handling of sensitive goods. Founded in 1859, Santa Fe was one of the largest railroads in North America up until 1995, when it merged with Burlington Northern to form BNSF.

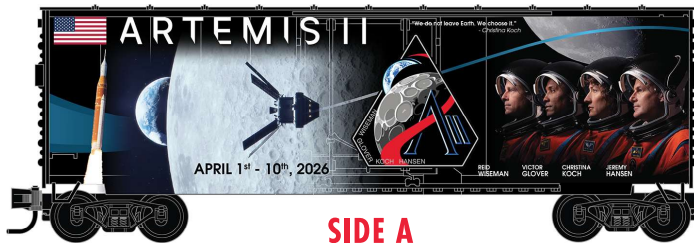
Artemis II

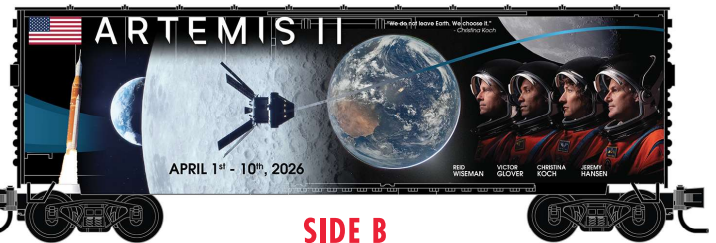

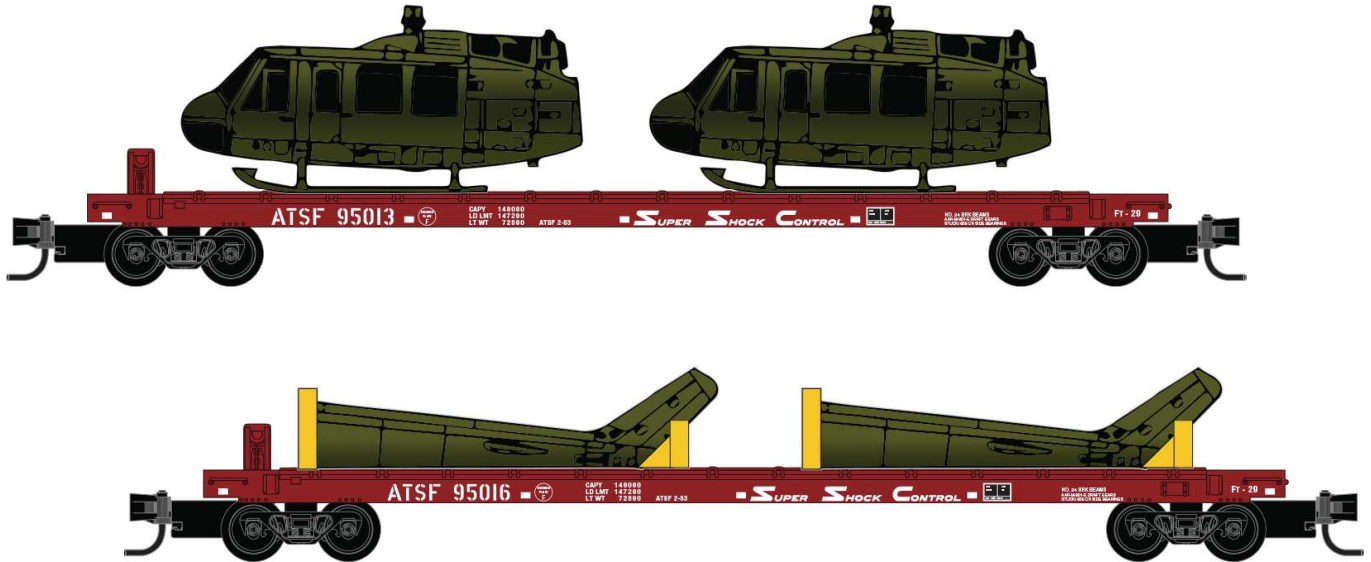

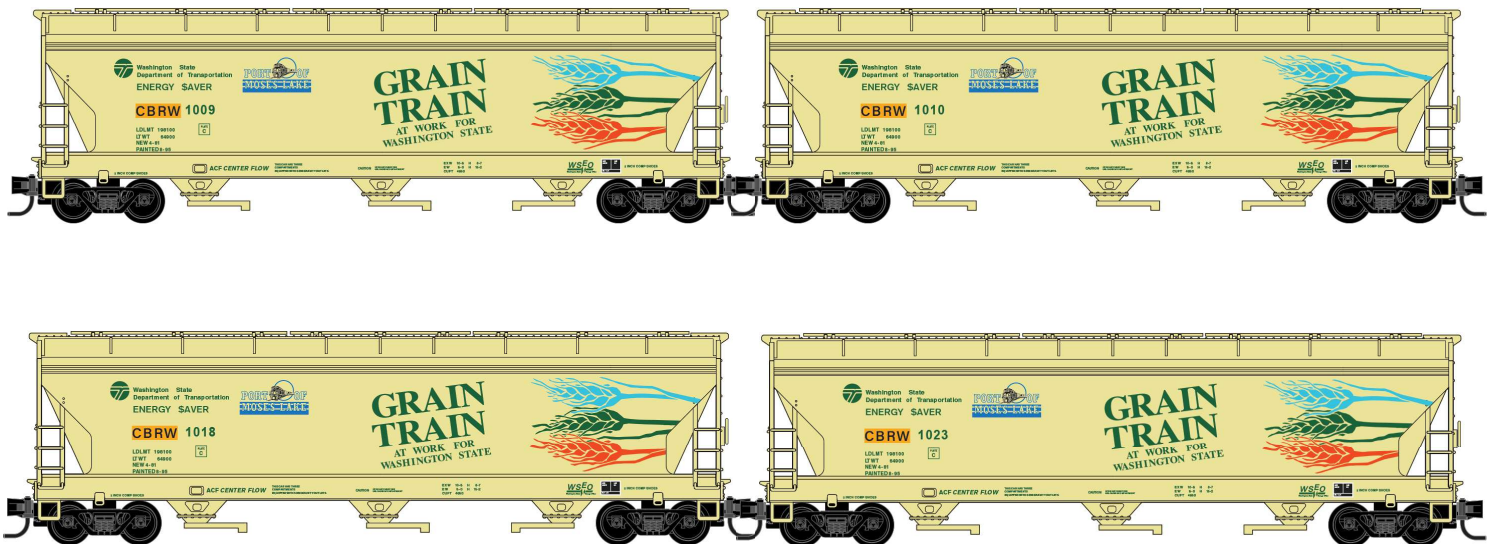

The Washington Grain Train started in 1994 and works with short line railways and BNSF within Washington to transport grain to deep-water ports for exporting grain to the Pacific Rim markets. While the freight cars are overseen by Washington State Department of Transportation, they have different reporting marks depending on which line they originate from. Columbia Basin Railroad (CBRW) runs roughly 27 cars in the grain train and interchange them with BNSF to reach Washington's ports.

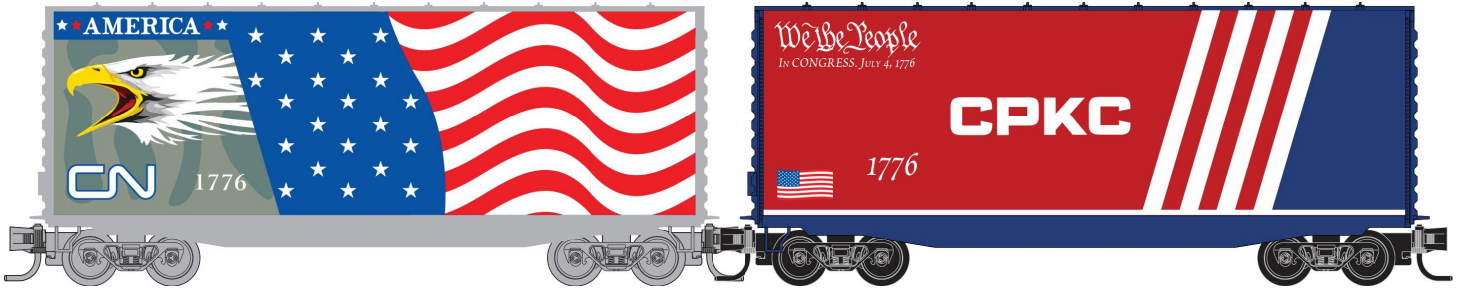

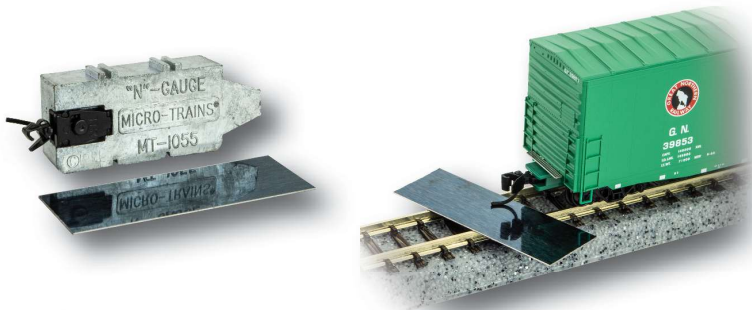

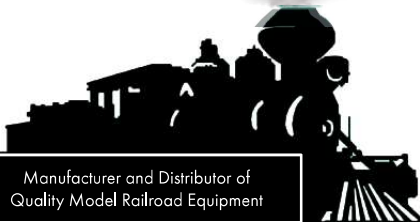
